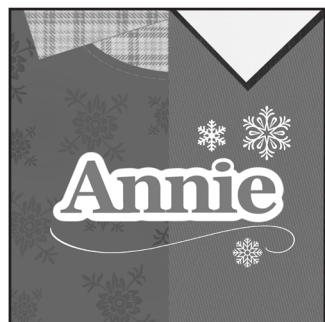

- Smoking – including vaping or the use of e-cigarettes – is prohibited in or within 100 feet of the Vernal Theatre.

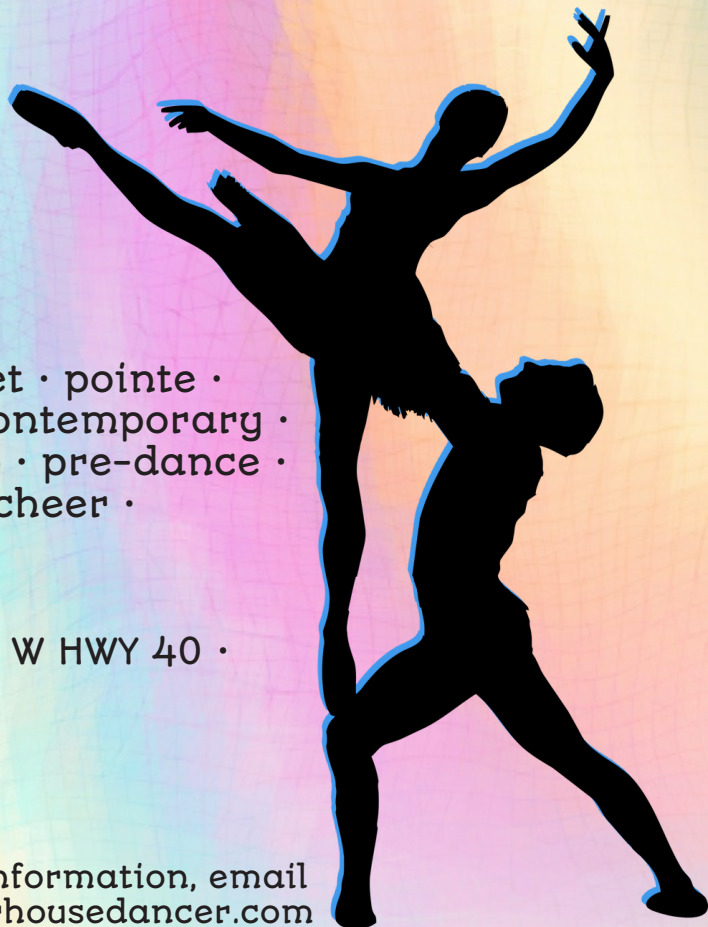

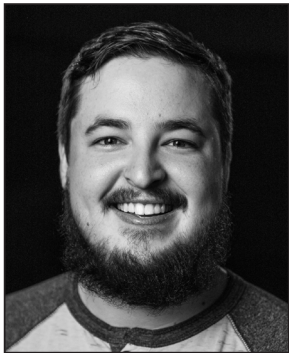
ANNA BROKAW *Ms. Green*

DEREK MEANEA *Mr. Boddy*

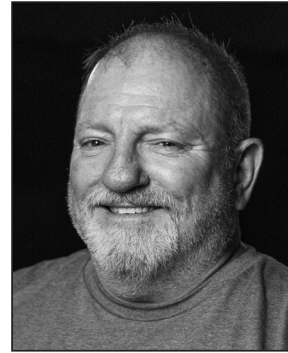
